Professional experience | After having worked as professional fire officer and instructor for eight years, Ian opted for a career in the maritime industry. He spent the next 13 years mainly in shore based positions. The years 2002 – 2007 saw him as chief instructor at the Hamble School of Yachting in Southampton, where he was responsible for all standards of tuition.

The following years he worked, amongst others, as principal of on deck training, setting up training bases in the UK, Portugal and Antigua, as marine consultant in Antigua, and as director and base manager in Portugal, overseeing all aspects of the marine company management and running VIP luxury yachting events. In between these positions, Ian also worked temporarily as captain, chief officer, OOW and instructor on board S/Ys ranging from 16m – 30m and on 65m M/Ys IMAGINE and LADY M, being responsible for ocean planning and preparations, doing tuitions on navigations, and transatlantic crossings.

In 2012 Ian took his first steps in the superyacht industry as second officer on board the busy charter yachts M/Y TURQUOISE and M/Y VICKY. He then was recruited by a captain to work together with him as chief officer on board M/Y KANALOA, M/Y SUNRISE and M/Y ANEDIGMI. In 2015, he took on his first captain's position on board the charter yacht M/Y MY SPACE. Afterwards, Ian worked as captain and 2nd captain on the busy private motor yachts ESSENCE, a 32m San Lorenzo, and 45m BRAVADO. He joined CALYPSO in April 2019.

Over the past two decades Ian has accrued approximately 230,000 nautical miles, having extensively cruised Northern European waters, the Mediterranean, Caribbean, Florida, the Magellan Straits in Chile and the Beagle Channel in Argentina, and Thailand. All in all, Ian has 29 crossings under his belt.

Ian has a great passion for all things on the water, particularly stand up paddle boards and personal water crafts. He is also very into motor sports, watches the Formula 1 and goes karting himself whenever he has anybody to race.

Professional experience | David started his career in May 2009 in the 5 star / 2AA rosettes hotel “MacDonald Hotels & Resorts – The Randolph Hotels” in Oxford as apprentice chef and was promoted to chef de partie within 3 years.

The next steps in his career saw him, amongst others, working as junior sous chef closely with Mark Askew, the former head chef of the 3 Michelin star-awarded Restaurant Gordon Ramsay and then owner of the Dundas Arms Public House in Newbury.

In 2013, after having worked concurrently at two restaurants to fund this trip, David travelled to Australia to work as chef de partie at the Hat awarded (equivalent to Michelin star) Pure South Restaurant, a Tasmanian influenced fine dining restaurant under Ashley Davies, former head chef of Hélène Darroze at the Connaught Hotel in Mayfair.

David spent the years 2014 – 2017 as head chef of the Folly Bridge Restaurant in Oxford and took on the challenge to turn a lacklustre business around and reinvigorate its reputation. He injected creativity into the menu, focussing on

delivering seasonal dishes of exceptional quality, using the very best fresh local produce. David's hard work and dedication paid off; he raised the restaurant's profile and received many glowing reviews in newspapers and online.

David's career took a new turn in 2018, when he decided to join the crew on board the 91m private sailing yacht NAHLIN as crew chef. Afterwards, he spent the summer season 2018 as sole chef on board 20m charter yacht M/Y WINI. He joined CALYPSO I in May 2019.

David has a strong skill set, developed through training and qualifications and honed under talented and experienced head chefs. He is passionate about food and delivering perfection on a plate to his guests.
